# WHAT IS A CONSOLIDATED PLAN?

- A 5-year strategic plan **required** by HUD for cities receiving federal formula grants
- Guides how Baton Rouge invests in housing, infrastructure, and community development
- Guides programs intended to improve the lives of low income persons in Baton Rouge
- Informed by data, community input, and local priorities





## HUD GRANTS BATON ROUGE RECEIVES

- 1. Community Development Block Grant (CDBG): Supports housing rehab, public infrastructure, blight removal, and services for low-income residents
- 2. HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME): Funds affordable housing construction, rental assistance, and homebuyer support
- 3. Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): Assists individuals and families experiencing or at risk of homelessness
- 4. Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA): Provides housing and supportive services for low-income people living with HIV/AIDS

### PLANNING TIMELINE AND PROCESS





#### **Plan Elements**

- Needs Assessment: Review housing, economic, and infrastructure needs
- Citizen Participation: Public hearings, surveys, and stakeholder input
- **Strategic Plan**: Set goals and funding priorities for 2025–2029
- Annual Action Plans: Detail specific projects and use of funds each year



2024 Median Household Income in the Baton Rouge Metro area is \$87,400 based on a <u>family of 4</u> persons.
